



## FUNDRAISING UPDATE - HELP – WE NEED YOU!

Our church is the ‘*heart of the community*’ – please take a few moments to read this update.

**Mission Reminder:** To make the main body of Holy Trinity a safer and warmer environment. The floor will be levelled in the nave, with a stone floor throughout. A new fume-free quieter and more efficient under-floor heating system will also be installed. The doors will be restored so that they fit properly, making them as draft free as possible and the wiring system will be updated.

**Objective:** To give us a more comfortable, flexible, safer space to prepare for services, occasional offices (baptisms, weddings, funerals) *Explorers* etc.

**Goal:** With your help we need to raise a total of **£203,000**.

An amazing **£70,738** has already been raised from individual donations, legacies, a contribution from the 009 Club AGM Dinner, the Safari Supper and a few successful grant applications (we are confident that more will follow in 2017!) as well as the many previous fundraising events. In addition, we also have Lord Carrington’s very generous offer of match funding up to £50,000 from December 2016 to December 2018. Following this, we feel confident in reaching our goal by December 2018. However, in order to achieve this – we still need your support!
