Soprano, Stephanie Bodsworth studied at the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland and the Royal College of Music. She has performed several times for Opera Holland Park and was a member of the Glyndebourne Chorus for three years, performing the role of Emmie in Sir Peter Hall's Albert Herring.

As well as touring extensively with Opera Brava, Stephanie has performed at the Proms with Glyndebourne Festival Chorus and made her international debut as Misha in the world premiere of The Carnival – A Circus Opera, in Hamburg.
