

RESUMPTION OF SUNDAY SERVICES IN HOLY TRINITY, BLEDLOW

A message from Norbert, our Vicar:

Dear Friends,

I am very delighted to inform you that we are now able to gather again for worship in our parish church. I look forward to worshipping with you. I am attaching below some information that will be helpful as we prepare to return to church. I would be very pleased to see many of you at the services, but it is important that we are careful and stay safe, especially those of us who are clinically vulnerable. In choosing to come to church, you risk being exposed to coronavirus. So I encourage you to stay at home if you are not healthy enough to attend a service without putting yourself or others at risk.

Preparing to return to church

When and Where? From 26 July at 10.30am at Holy Trinity Church

- Entry to church will be only by the south doors, and there will be a one-way system in operation.
- Social distancing will be necessary at all times. Seating will be 2 metres apart (except for families).
- Capacity will depend on whether people are in groups or alone, but we expect it will be between 30 and 40 people.
- From 8th August masks are compulsory in church. Please bring your own.
- We will continue to stream online services during August.
- Communion by hand only at the Holy Communion service
- No shaking hands. No hymns or printed material
- Church will be cleaned and sanitized after each service.
- There will be only one service in the parish at Holy Trinity.

2 August	Holy Communion
9 August	Matins
16 August	Family Praise
23 August	Matins
30 August	Holy Communion
